Re-opening of Bay Ridge School Protocol September 2021

- 1. The Board voted to make masks optional. This will be visited throughout the year as concerns arise about Covid 19.
- 2. All students on the school bus are mandated to wear masks.
- 3. The school will provide masks for those children riding the bus, for students who wear masks at school and for teachers who want masks.
- 4. Children will not be mandated to wear masks out of doors.
- 5. The school nurse will provide Bay Ridge with information regarding Pool Testing. Parents can choose to have their child(ren) participate.
- 6. The school nurse has provided a flow chart in regards to how to respond to a possible Covid case and/or close contact. This flow chart can be made available to parents through the school's secretary.

- 7. All meals for children at Bay Ridge will be at no charge this year. However, meal application will be collected for data purposes.
- 8. Bay Ridge is a School Wide Title 1 school as part of our CNA plan. Any child can receive Title 1 services due to Loss of Learning.
- 9. Proper hand cleaning will continue to be promoted.
- 10. Students' desks will continue to be spaced a reasonable distance apart.
- 11. Cleaning throughout the school will be done by Bay Ridge's janitorial staff. In classroom cleaning, such as sanitizing desks, will be done by either the janitorial staff or classroom teacher.
- 12. The cleaning of the school bus will continue to be the responsibility of the bus driver.
- 13. Covid testing is available through Lori Martin for staff and students; students must have parent permission. The over the counter testing will not be accepted.

- 14. All teachers are preparing their students to become familiar again with Remote Learning in case Bay Ridge needs to close.
- 15. All students have taken pre & post placement tests to assist in identifying those who have a Loss of Learning. Individualized instruction will be given to those who are below meets the requirements.
